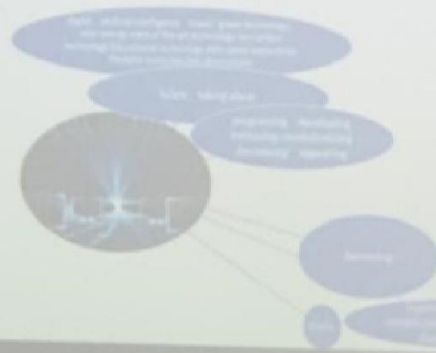

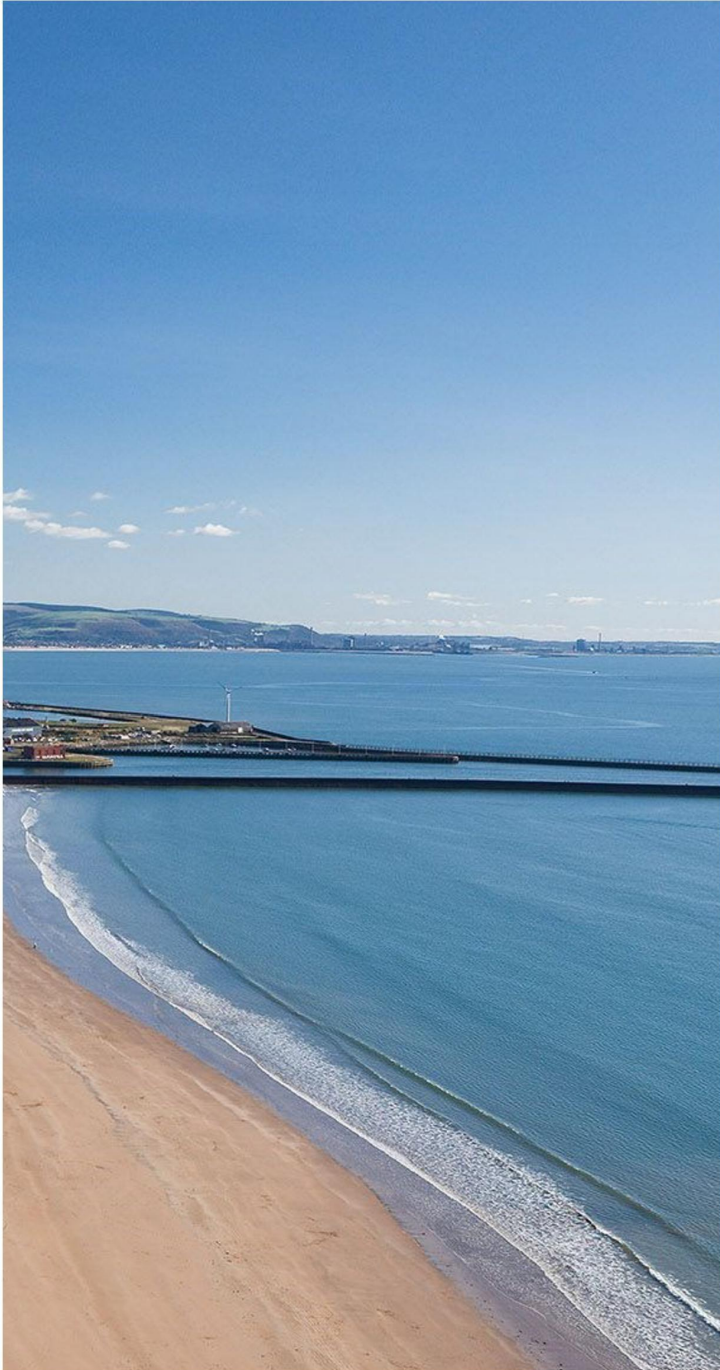

GETTING HERE

City School of Languages (CSL) is located in Swansea along the South Coast of Wales, one hour away from the Capital, Cardiff.

Swansea is easily accessible from a number of international airports; London Heathrow, Gatwick, Manchester, Bristol, and the closest to Swansea being Cardiff Airport.

From the airport you can get to Swansea by either train, coach or taxi. There are excellent train connections between London Paddington train station and Swansea train station. Alternatively a cheaper option is travelling by coach from London Victoria Coach Station to Swansea Bus station.

For a faster and most comfortable journey, we can arrange a taxi transfer for you from the Airport to your accommodation in Swansea.

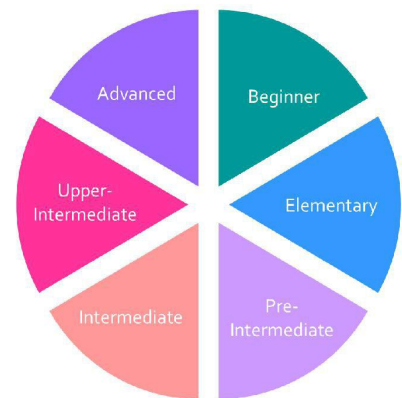
City School of Languages runs classes for all levels; Beginner all the way to Advanced level.

Each lesson is split into three stages:

Stage 1 – Language input

In the classroom, a task is set by your teacher with clear aims and objectives; useful language, vocabulary and phrases are introduced.

Example tasks:

Planning a dinner party; Describing people; Asking for directions; Learning about the history of Swansea; Slang; Traveling in the UK

Stage 2 – 'Out There' Activity

You and your class go to a venue in Swansea, where you are split into small groups and complete a task entirely in English. During this time, your teacher will be walking around, assisting you with the task but also helping you gain more confidence with your language skills.

Stage 3 – Feedback

Your class meet up again and your teacher conducts a feedback session. Here you discuss if the tasks were successful or not; any language you were missing; how it could be improved and any important cultural points.

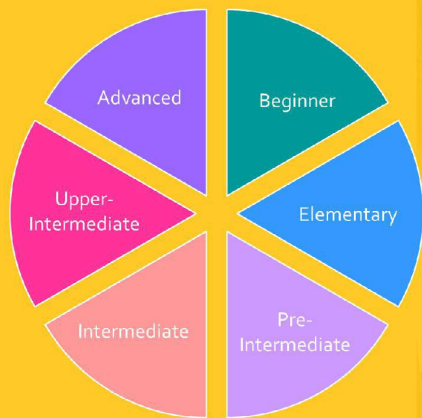

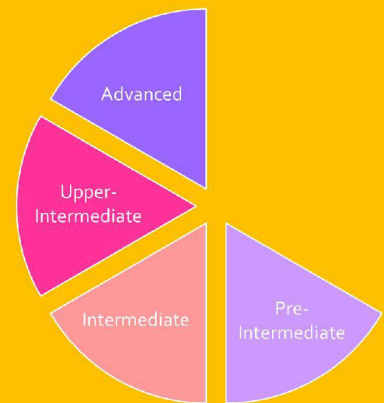

OET (OCCUPATIONAL ENGLISH TEST) PREPARATION COURSE

COURSE PROFILE

The OET (Occupational English Test) is accepted by both the UK Nursing & Midwifery Council (NMC) and the General Medical Council (GMC) as evidence of your ability to communicate effectively in English. CSL's OET Preparation course meets the needs of Healthcare professionals in the UK who require a minimum of a Grade B in each of the four skills: listening, reading, writing and speaking. By taking a CSL OET course, you will feel more confident when you take the exam and be well equipped to succeed.

LEVELS AVAILABLE

- OET 1 Week: Has already achieved a minimum of 7.0 in each component (reading, writing, listening, speaking) in different IELTS tests or no lower than 6.5 in one or two
- OET 2 Weeks: Has already achieved a 6.0 or 6.5 in each component of the IELTS exam (but not a 7.0) OR has an overall 6.5 but has one component no lower than a 5.5
- If your overall score is lower than the levels required for entry to the OET 1 and 2 week courses, please contact us to discuss how we can help you.

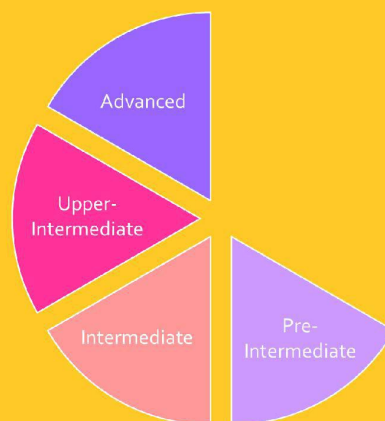

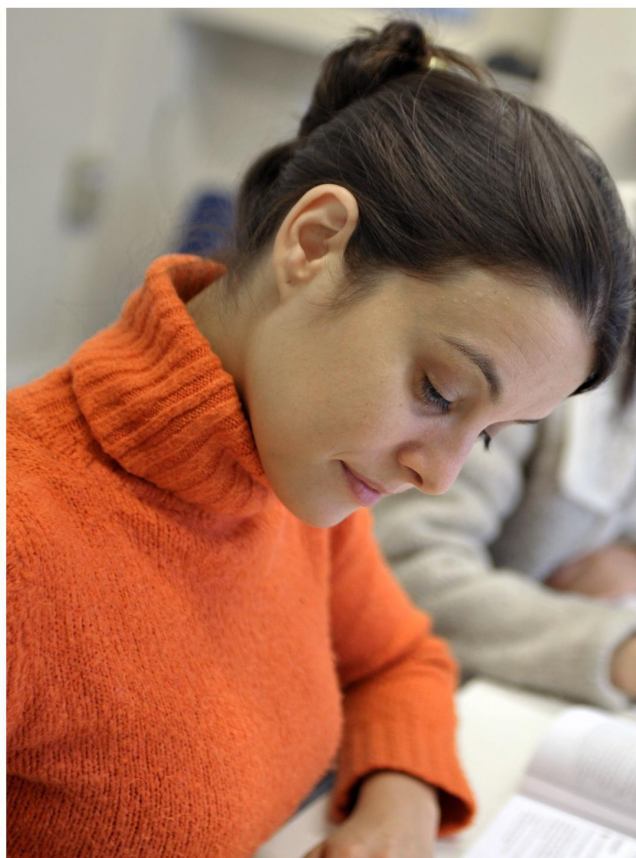
AIMS OF THE COURSE

COURSE PROFILE

Your programme starts with one of our English courses (part-time 20 lessons or full-time 28 lessons) for a minimum of two weeks. Once you have completed your time at the School, you will then be placed in one of our local partner companies, where you will complete a work placement. Your work placement can last from between one week to six months. Every Friday afternoon, a member of staff will meet with you to ensure that you are benefiting from your stay.
